We understand a ‘Built Territory’ to be a large-scale place in continuous transformation, linked to an economic activity and to a particular technique that gives shape to its physicality. As opposed to the architectural project, built territories have no final destination, all iterations in the evolution process are of the same importance. This semester we will visit the salt marshes in Cádiz, the quarry in Rio Tinto, the wineries in San Martín de Torres, the Castilla canal, the Roman quarry of Las Médulas and the Añana Salt Valley, engaging in an ongoing discussion on how the construction of societies and the definition of civic space literally ‘build’ the territory.
